HISTORY OF AUSTRALIAN TABLE TENNIS

Table Tennis Australia is the sole governing body for the sport of Table Tennis in Australia and sets the rules and policies that governs Table Tennis in the many clubs and associations throughout the country.

Table Tennis was first played in Australia in Adelaide in 1898.

In 1923 the South Australian Table Tennis Association was formed as was the Queensland Association. The Victorian Table Tennis Association began its operations in 1925 and New South Wales in 1930.

Following interstate visits by these four associations the Australian Board of Control was formed in 1933. This very same year saw the first Australian Championships being played in Melbourne with only male players competing. In 1936 affiliation with the International Table Tennis Federation was made and also in this year females participated in the Australian Championships for the first time.

In 1937 the Board of Control was reconstructed and became the Australian Table Tennis Association (ATTA). In 1937 the tennis system of scoring was discontinued in favour of the international 'points' system. Tasmania affiliated with the ATTA in the same year.

The first official visit by Australian players was in 1940, when at the initiative of Japan, two players competed in the Pan Pacific tournament in Tokyo.

From late 1940 until 1946, Table Tennis on an organised basis came to a standstill due to World War II, however the game was played extensively in defence camps and for charitable purposes. To revive the

game after the war, a special meeting was held in 1947 and the Constitution was revised and General Regulations were adopted.

In 1952 Ron Jones was awarded the first Life Membership for his service as Secretary/ Treasurer and later became President until 1966, a total of 20 years service to Australian Table Tennis.

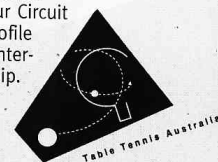
Mrs Suzy Javor won her tenth Australian Women's Singles title in 1970 and also that year won her eighth Women's Doubles title which is now named in her honour. In 1973 Miss Leanne Morrow became the youngest ever National Champion winning the Australian Open Women's Singles title at the age of 14.

In 1988 Australian Table Tennis sent its first players to the Olympic Games with Nadia Bisiach, Kerri Tepper and Gary Haberl competing in Seoul.

In 1994 Melbourne hosted the very successful 7th World Veterans Table Tennis Championships in which over 1800 competitors from 52 countries participated in the largest ever Table Tennis event in Australia.

The 1996 Commonwealth Bank Australian Open Table Tennis Championships held in Brisbane became a part of the ITTF Pro Tour Circuit for the first time, changing the profile of the event into a fully fledged internationally recognised Championship.

History moves to Melbourne in 1997 for the biggest and best Australian Open Table Tennis Championships yet.

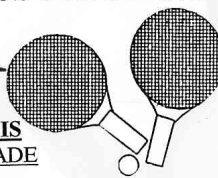

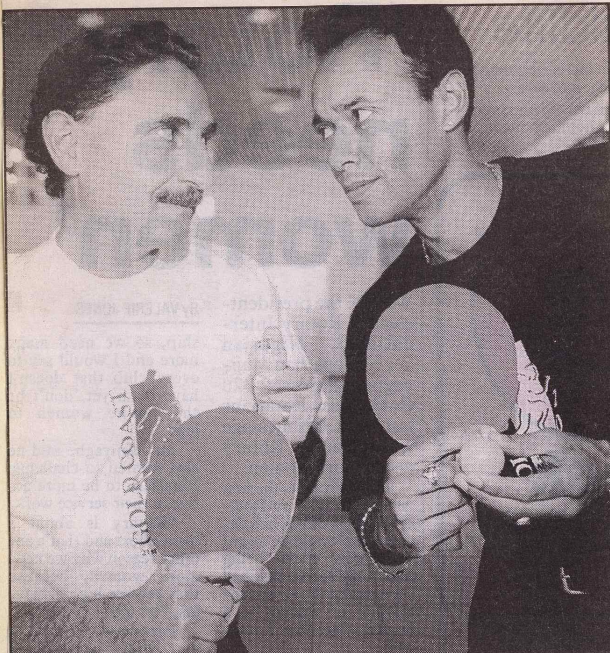
