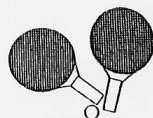

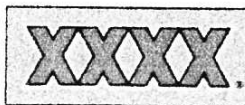

**WELCOME** to players, officials, sponsors and supporters as we unveil the first Table Tennis Queensland Top 10 Tournament and All-Star Weekend.

As custodians of an Olympic sport striving to achieve a higher profile as Sydney 2000 approaches, the executive of TTQ devised an initiative designed to revitalise its major events program.

This is the first such event in the calendar, bringing together the leading male and female players in the state in pursuit of a \$2,000 cash prize pool.

Each player will meet in a demanding two days of elite competition, with a star-studded Saturday night Sportsman's Dinner at Pelerman's on the River, Nerang, at which Australian Test cricket star Ian Healy, former

world solo speedway champion Ivan Mauger and the world's No 2 surfer, golden girl Trudy Todd will be among the guests.

The weekend will be a non-stop gathering of glittering names not only from Table Tennis and other sports, but also state and local government, the corporate sector and the Gold Coast public.

Before the first ball was struck there was every indication the occasion was headed for a huge success. It would not have been possible without the generous support of sponsors, the enthusiasm of the administrators and above all the commitment of the players.

Thanks to you all and have a great weekend.

## MEET THE CONTENDERS

In arguably the most comprehensive test of Queensland table tennis strength in depth, the state's elite players will dispute the prestige and prize money attached to this inaugural Top 10 tournament.

The women's section looks especially interesting, with a combination of experience and emerging young players rising to the challenge.

A two-day, nine-round competition is more of a marathon than a sprint and will test the staying power of all competitors. That is an area in which some of the youngsters will fancy their chances, possibly none more so than Peri Campbell-Innes whose early season form has been meteoric.

The Wynnum teenager has been winning open events, and a bright display in the Australian youth titles at Easter earned her a call-up for Australia B in the Under 20 section of the recent Oceania championships.

The men's section contains the two Queenslanders who won international selection last year in former junior champion Kent Jamieson, who was in the Australian squad for the Commonwealth and World Championships, and Martin Rogers, a member of the team at the Global Youth Championships. Jamieson (Toowoomba), back home after stints in

China, Sweden and more recently Melbourne, started the Queensland season in winning mood and will be a strong favourite.

But reigning Queensland champion Seref Bakanay (Brisbane) is sure to pose a big threat; he has a consistent record in recent seasons and is usually there or thereabouts in the final reckoning.

Anthony Jeffress is a club colleague also likely to test a few.

Bodo Rose (Wynnum) can never be ruled out and with a strong contingent of team-mates including Nathan Hurst and the youthful and fast-improving Craig Hayes, will have more reasons than enough to shine.

Interest will focus on Rogers, winner in successive years of the Australian and New Zealand youth titles and recently returned from a Belgian League season. He is one of a trio of Gold Coasters, the others being wily veterans Vladimir Ktoiants and Thomas Samuelsson who boast impressive overseas experience.

Completing the men's 10 is Paul Jones, widely-travelled but never to be underestimated and newly installed in a full-time coaching role at Mackay.

Andrea McDonnell (Lower Burdekin) and Gayle D'Arcy (Wynnum) are two of the best-credentialed players in the women's ranks with a swag of representative appearances behind them.

The next phase is represented by the likes of Aldwyn Altuneg (Gold Coast) and Fiona McDonnell (Lower Burdekin) both of whom were in the Queensland team in last year's Australian championships.

If the form book suggests they are the contenders most likely to threaten the Campbell-Innes charge, Therese Chappell (Brisbane) has emerged as a force along with the equally-experienced Pam Clarke (Rockhampton), while Wynnum's Rebecca Hurst has chalked up some good tournament results.

The Coast-based Belinda Saunders (Wynnum) and Erica Clarke (Rockhampton) also are still in the junior ranks where they have produced some moments of clear promise, so one can foresee a competition in which no reputation is safe.

A strong overseas contingent will be in Melbourne from August 27-30 for the Australian Open, part of the ITTF World Pro Tour. Melbourne also is the setting for the Australian inter-state teams and individual championships from September 13 - 18.

## TOTS TABLE TENNIS

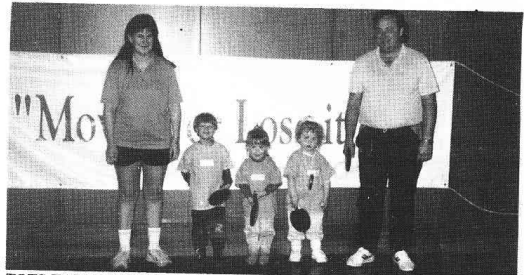

Finals of the table tennis will be held at the Gold Coast Table tennis Association, Herbertson Dr, Molendiner today between midday and 3.00.

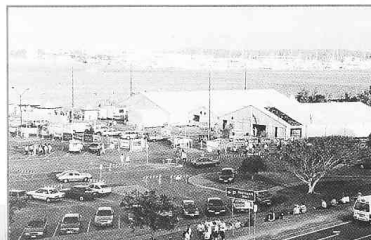
